CONFERENCE PROGRAM & VOLUNTEERS

The event begins with morning breakout sessions on budgeting, understanding credit and paying for college utilizing BAFEF's Student Workshop Modules. Volunteers join the event at lunch and enjoy general sessions with speakers Saira Malik, CIO of Nuveen Investments and Darcy Illg, CFO of Ramsell Corporation. Volunteers spend the majority of the afternoon as mentors paired 1:1 with the girls, reviewing content from the morning personal finance sessions on an individual basis, discussing career options & professional development, and offering encouragement for young women entering into male-dominated fields. A closing session will recap the day's highlights with testimonials from the girls. BAFEF provides conversational structure and pre-conference educational materials for the volunteers to review and prepare.
